I have a question on the NOFO that was just released. I saw that the max grant amount was \$121,500 (which is what we currently receive). However, some of our other state funders are pushing across mandatory pay range increases, which are then affecting our entire pay scale. Is there a possibility of receiving additional funding to help cover salary/benefit increases?

\$121,500 is the maximum grant award for non-Chicago sites in SFY23.
