Juvenile commitment rates reveal significant racial disparity

In 2003, African-American youth in Illinois were committed to Illinois Department of Corrections at a level nearly three times their representation in the general juvenile population of the state. In contrast, Hispanic, Asian/Pacific Islander, and Caucasian youth were incarcerated at levels less than their respective representation in the general juvenile population of Illinois.


An assessment was conducted in each Illinois county that had a sufficient percentage of minority youth to measure disproportionate contact.

African-American youth were over-represented among youth committed to IDOC in 30 of 42 counties studied. Hispanic youth were over-represented in 14 of 57 counties, and Asian/Pacific Islander youth were over-represented in two of 31 counties.

Statewide, African-American youth were committed to IDOC at a rate that was more than five times the rate of Caucasian youth in 2003. Hispanic youth were committed at a rate that was 45 percent greater than the rate of Caucasian youth. Asian/Pacific-Islander youth were committed to IDOC at just more than one-tenth the rate of Caucasian youth.

- In 28 counties, African-American youth were committed to IDOC at more than twice the rate of Caucasian youth.
